

Peter Kranz Scholarships

- 1) Kranz money is available to any graduate student in the Combined PhD program who is in good standing and is on campus or completing internship. Money is not available to students post-internship.
- 2) These funds are to be used for student expenses related to professional development activities, including research, clinical practice, and teaching. Some examples of what would be considered appropriate are attending additional conferences to further your professional development or doing a dissertation that you might not be able to do without monetary support. These funds are not intended for anything that you would have to do to get your degree.
- 3) Expenses that are not considered acceptable are:
 - Tuition and fees.
 - Travel to internship interviews.
 - Travel back to USU to do your defense
 - Textbooks required for classes.
 - Membership dues as per University Policy 522 "Membership and Dues"
 - Printing costs for students' Theses and Dissertations
 - Computers (There is an ownership issue on computers)
- 4) Each year any new donation from Dr. Kranz will be divided up evenly among the combined students enrolled for that year.
- 5) Students will have two years to use the money. If they have not used the money by the start of the third year, it will revert back into the scholarship fund. Funds not used from previous years may be divided up among the current year's students. This will be done at the discretion of the Department Head.
- 6) Students will be asked to write a thank you letter to Dr. Kranz describing how they used the scholarship funds.
